## Children's Ministries (Birth-6th Grade)

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Nursery Teacher/Helper** - Hillside's Nursery seeks to provide a warm, caring environment where children can experience God's love. Nursery servants will teach children how to make friends and learn about Jesus through Bible stories, crafts, games, songs and puppets. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, or Helping.*

**Nursery Check-In Supervisor** - Nursery Supervisors will greet young children and parents, take attendance, issue nametags and pagers, direct children to appropriate classrooms and assist nursery staff as needed. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Leadership, Hospitality, or Administration.*

**Children's Teacher** - Using excellent materials which are provided, children's teachers commit to share Christ and His message to a small group of children. Our teachers impact the lives of kids by being relational, providing hands-on learning experiences, and highlighting Scripture's life applications on age appropriate levels. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, or Evangelism.*

**Children's Helper** - Support teachers by being an extra set of hands to help with projects (glitter and glue) and clean up. Help find Scripture (Bible searches can be a challenge), and smile and laugh with classes. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, or Helping.*

**Administrative Helper** - With the multitude of children enrolled at Hillside, preparation for tracking and follow-up is essential for excellence in programming. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Administration or Helping.*

**4th-6th Grade Leader** - By playing games, making friends, discussing Bible points, and sharing God's love to 4th-6th graders. Rising Tide is a dynamic program that encourages Christian growth. Sunday School and Mission Adventures all have specific activities designed for this age. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, or Evangelism.*

**Children with Special Needs Helper** - "Let the children come to me" is one of Christ's sayings. *All children.* At Hillside, we have a small number of special needs children who need a one-on-one helper in established teacher-led classes to assist them. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, Mercy, or Helping.*

**Seasonal Event Assistance** - Seasonal Events are one-day family programs offered to build up the spiritual life of the family through engaging activities such as game nights, helping families assemble gingerbread houses, staffing a prayer walk and special family mission projects. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Hospitality, Administration, Helping, or Creative Communication.*

### Frequency & Timing of Service

Serve twice a month or more for 1 worship service on Sunday mornings; serve twice a month or more on Sunday evenings. Servants should be age 12 and older.

Serve twice a month or more for 1 worship service on Sunday mornings; serve twice a month or more on Sunday evenings or Wednesday evenings.

Serve weekly, on Sunday morning, Sunday evening, or Wednesday evening. Servants should be Sr. High and older or Jr. High with an interview.

Serve weekly or twice monthly, on Sunday morning, Sunday evening, or Wednesday evening.

Help is needed at various times during the week as well as during program times.

Choose from Sunday a.m., Sunday p.m., and Wednesday p.m.

"Extra Special" helpers need to commit weekly at a particular worship hour to best assist a particular child.

Each Seasonal Event is scheduled independently.

## Children's Ministries (Birth-6th Grade) continued

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Vacation Bible School Servant** - VBS weeks are action-packed, where the energy and excitement are infectious. A veritable army of servants is needed to run VBS. Travel guides, games, crafts, Bible stories, video, music, and decorations all play a part. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Evangelism, Hospitality, Administration, Helping, or Creative Communication.*

**Sky High** is for our younger children, Pre-K 4's - 3rd grade, with a full nursery program for servants. Over 250 servants are needed with a minimum of 100 adults for the program to occur.

**Marketplace Babylon** is for 4th - 6th graders. Servants must be 9th grade and older. More than 50 servants are needed with a minimum of 14 adult men for the program to occur.

**Bible Camp Leader** - Adult and youth servants will serve in areas of games, crafts, music, missions, snack, and as classroom leaders and assistants for children age 2 years through 5th grade. Leaders may serve one week or all three weeks.

## Youth Ministries (7th-12th Grade)

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Adult Youth Leader** - Adults who love Jesus and truly care about teens. These adults seek to develop relationships with teens in order to let them know about Jesus Christ and His love for them! This is done in several ways: helping with our Tuesday (Jr. High) or Thursday (Sr. High) night service, participating in events, and/or facilitating a small group. Interview and training process in order to make sure that this ministry is the right fit for those interested as well as to help determine the best way to use an individual's gifts. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, Evangelism, Leadership, or Creative Communication.*

**Student Servant-Leader in the Jr. High Ministry** - A Student Servant-Leader is a qualified 11th or 12th grader who has a vibrant relationship with Christ and our Christian community. They serve at XZone on Tuesday nights by leading games, dramas & building relationships with junior highers. They may also be asked to share their testimony, assist a small group, and attend retreats. Application, interview and training meetings required. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Leadership, or Creative Communication.*

**Student Servant-Leader in the Children's Ministry** - A Student Servant-Leader is a qualified 7th through 12th grader who has a growing relationship with Christ and our Christian community. These students serve either on Sunday mornings by teaching or assisting in Sunday School classes, on Sunday evenings with Shipmates or Rising Tide, or Wednesday evenings teaching skills with Mission Adventure. May also be asked to help with special events including VBS and Family Festivals. Application, interview and training meetings required. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Leadership, or Creative Communication.*

## Youth Ministries (7th-12th Grade) continued

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Behind the Scenes Servants** - Help by using your gifts to provide for the Youth ministry on a consistent or occasional basis. Examples could be to help serve snacks, pray before or during youth gatherings, open your home for a small group to use, help with technical needs, drive for an event, etc. You will be contacted about the ways you can help and you can respond as you are able. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Hospitality, Administration, or Helping.*

**Parking Lot Shepherds** - Help in the parking lot and halls of the church before, during and after weekly large group meetings by helping students find the meeting area, encouraging and redirecting wanderers, and being present as students depart. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, or Helping.*

## Adult Ministries

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Adult Group or Study Leader** - Agree to be a part of a teaching team to lead other adults in study of Scripture and/or foundational beliefs and practices of the Christian faith. Leadership opportunities may include: Sunday School, Disciple Bible Study, Christian Believer, Small Group Studies, 2-Hour Workshops, as well as other seasonal groups based on the worship calendar. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, Evangelism, or Leadership.*

**Women of Hillside** - Team members share a passion to bring Christ's love to all of our sisters at Hillside and in our community.

**Leadership Team:** Prayerfully executes the vision of where God is leading the ministry and has primary responsibility for the content of all event programming and budget planning. Members will head up ministry programs. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Leadership, or Administration.*

**Breakfast Team:** Plans the menu, gets servants to help provide the food, decorates, sets up, and cleans up. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Hospitality, or Leadership.*

**Dinner Team:** Plans and executes special dinner events. Includes menu planning, catering planning, ticket sales on Sunday mornings, coordinating set-up, and decorating. Does NOT include planning the program. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Hospitality, or Leadership.*

**Special Events Team:** Executes special events such as Anita Renfroe, the Lysa TerKeurst Day Conference and Ginny Owens. Coordinates all things related to these events (i.e., facilities, accommodations, transportation, ticket sales, registrations, etc.) once it is scheduled by the Leadership Team. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Hospitality, or Leadership.*

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

#### Women of Hillside - continued

**Bible Study Leader:** Lead ladies through a Scriptural based study, open to anyone, designed to encourage spiritual growth and application of God's Word in our lives. Training and resources provided. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, Evangelism, or Leadership.*

**Consignment Sale Planning Team:** Plans and executes the semi-annual Consignment Sale. Includes marketing, servant coordination, set-up, charity donations, and overall management. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Hospitality, Leadership, or Administration.*

**Small Group Leader:** This person has the desire and commitment to connect with a group of 6-10 ladies in a small accountability group. Training and resources provided. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, Evangelism, or Leadership.*

**Men of Hillside -** Assist in any number of Men's Ministry areas. The Planning Team is responsible for general planning, oversight, and communication of all aspects of the ministry. The Retreat, Breakfast, BBQ, Missions, Golf Fund Raiser and Special Events Teams will plan and administer specific ministry areas. The Spiritual Guidance Team encourages spiritual growth through men's small groups and studies. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Teaching, Encouragement, Evangelism, Hospitality, Leadership, or Administration.*

**Office Duties & Welcoming/Bulletin Preparation -** Servants perform various administrative duties, which can include phone reception and main office reception. They may assist with mailings, copying, stuffing envelopes and other light office duties. In addition, servants are needed occasionally when special items need to be inserted into the bulletin. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Hospitality, Administration, or Helping.*

**Hillside Library & Cross Reference Bookstore -** The library and bookstore seeks to serve Hillside by encouraging reading and study to further our community's walk with Christ. The servants help make available Christian-based books, entertainment, and other materials. Servants help direct our patrons to books and other materials available in the library and bookstore. We also help prepare these materials for check-out in the library or for sale in the bookstore. Training is provided. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Evangelism, Hospitality, Administration, or Helping.*

## Helping/Compassion/Congregational Care

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**New Baby Ministry -** Team visits families after the birth or adoption of a child. When visiting, servants bring a gift bag filled with current information about Hillside's nursery and children's programs as well as items contributed by other Hillside Ministries. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, or Helping.*

### Frequency & Timing of Service

Preparation of study material required. Studies meet weekly until completed with the hope that the group decides to continue meeting.

Sales in March & August. Meets weekly for 2 months prior to each sale and supports the sale itself at a scheduled time.

Groups meet weekly.

Varies per team or event.

On an as-needed basis.

Serve at various times, at least twice a month. Servants should be Jr. High and older.

### Frequency & Timing of Service

When servants are called about a delivery, visits are to be made within 7 days.

## Helping/Compassion/Congregational Care continued

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Funeral & Memorial Service Assistants** - Help with preparations and assist the family the day of the service. Training is provided. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, or Mercy.*

**Casserole Ministry** - Servants prepare and deliver a meal for those in our midst who are having a difficult time. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, Mercy or Helping.*

#### **Prayer Ministry -**

**Leadership Team:** These servants will gather to coordinate and provide intentional opportunities for our congregation and community to enter into prayer. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Leadership, Mercy, Helping or Intercession/Prayer.*

**Prayer Chain:** Pray for those who have requested prayer and/or write notes of encouragement to them. You will receive notices of prayer needs for persons who either requested prayer for themselves or for others. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Mercy, Helping or Intercession/Prayer.*

**Prayer Room Servant:** These servants will make “appointments with God” for prayer in Hillside’s Prayer Room on specific days and times. Information is provided to guide prayers for a number of topics, including Hillside’s worship services and its missions and ministries. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Mercy, Helping or*

### Frequency & Timing of Service

## Hospitality/Welcoming

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Greeter Team** - These servants assist in the weekly worship experiences by providing a warm and inviting welcome to all guests. They provide valuable information and instruction, including assistance with directions to locations within the building. Greeters may also, at times, be invited to distribute information to accompany and enhance the themes and messages in worship. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, or Helping.*

**Usher Team** - These servants assist in the weekly worship experiences by welcoming all guests, providing information and instruction, distributing bulletins, assisting with seating and the flow of people in an out of worship spaces, collecting the morning’s offering, and in other ways during the service as needed. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, or Helping.*

**Parking Greeter** - Servants assist in the weekly worship experiences by welcoming all guests as they arrive in the parking lot. They direct traffic flow, both of vehicles and pedestrians, as people arrive and depart. This area of service offers an opportunity to make a friendly first impression with our guests! *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, or Helping.*

### Frequency & Timing of Service

Greeters serve on a rotation with other greeters in 30 to 40 minute time slots on Sunday mornings.

Ushers serve on a rotation with other Ushers for approximately 75 minutes on a Sunday morning. Servants should be age 13 and older unless serving with an adult.

Serve on a rotation with other parking greeters, typically serving for several hours on one Sunday each month. Servants should be age 21 and older.

## Hospitality/Welcoming continued

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Welcome Desk** - These servants assist in the weekly worship experiences by welcoming all guests, providing information and instruction, and by providing a place for guests to have their specific questions quickly answered. This team will often answer questions regarding Sunday School options, Bible Studies and Classes, and midweek program times or locations. The Welcome Desk servants also collect registration information or special information from worship. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Hospitality, or Helping.*

**Special Event Hospitality Team** - The Special Event Hospitality Team functions as a welcoming and hospitable first-impression team when we have occasional events throughout the year such as plays, musicals, fairs, seminars, etc. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts:*

**Visitation Team** - Welcome returning visitors to Hillside by hand delivering a gift and ministry information to their homes, and provide willing ears to listen and warm smiles of welcome. Gift bags and ministry information, as well as maps and visitor information, are provided to you. Visitation is done each week throughout the year. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, or Hospitality.*

**Call 1st Time Visitors** - On Monday or Tuesday team members are emailed the phone numbers of the past Sunday's 1st time visitors. They then give the visitor a welcome call and answer any questions they might have about Hillside. The visitor team then reports back to the Membership Office by email about their phone conversations. Team members are usually not given more than two families to call; exceptions would be holiday services where there are many 1st time visitors. Information and training is provided. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, or Helping.*

**Communion Bread Baking Ministry** - Team servants are responsible for baking the communion bread used in weekly worship services. Recipe provided. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Hospitality or Helping.*

## Missions & Community Outreach

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Meals On Wheels Delivery** - Reach out to our community with love by visiting the sick, the tired, and the lonely. Deliver a hot meal and provide a little companionship through this well established, county wide program. You can connect with senior citizens and serve one-on-one with people who have rich lives. *Recommended Spiritual Gifts: Encouragement, Evangelism, Mercy, or Helping.*

### Frequency & Timing of Service

Welcome Desk servants serve on a rotation in 90 minute time slots on Sunday mornings. Servants should be in Sr. High and older.

Varies based on need.

Weekly, the Visitation Team picks up bags and visitor sheets from the church and hand delivers them.

Weekly all year.

Serve in a rotation with other team servants.

### Ministry Name & Description of Service

**Drama Ministry** - This team of actors, puppeteers & set/costume designers contributes to the worship experiences by engaging us in dramatic depictions of circumstances that help us connect to the message and meaning of worship. **Chancel Choir** - This group helps to lead worship in our Traditional Worship services, as well as preparing and presenting special musical offerings through the year, ranging in style from spirituals to classical repertoire.
